When you're ready for dinner, head to [Bella Luna Wood Fired Pizza](#). Guests can actually watch their pizza being hand-crafted on-site using an authentic Italian method. Everything is made from scratch at this restaurant, and the ingredients are both seasonal and farm fresh.

If you have room for dessert, you can walk across the street to Bella Luna's sister restaurant, [Bella Gelato & Pastries](#). Everything here is prepared fresh daily, too, and the gelato is made with local milk from Mount Crawford Creamery.

DAY 2

Begin your second day in Harrisonburg with a tranquil trip to [Cedar Stone Wellness Spa](#). Here you will find a plethora of services including facials, massages, manicures, pedicures, scrubs, and soaks. This spa also offers specially-priced group event packages, which are perfect for your girl's getaway.

Now it's time to explore! At the [White Oak Lavender Farm](#) on Cross Keys Road in Harrisonburg, you can indulge in all things lavender-inspired. This farm grows over 8,000 lavender plants and makes their own essential oil, which you can find in the on-site gift shop. You will also have the opportunity to explore the Discovery Area for only \$3.00 per person. This is the ultimate relaxation spot in which you will have access to the duck pond, labyrinth, distillery, petting area, drying barn, and gardens.
