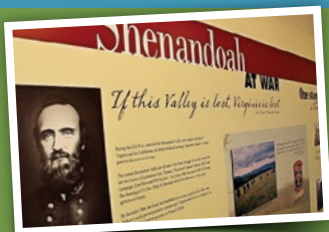


Visitor Information. Travel Specialists are available to answer questions, provide information and general travel assistance. Brochures, maps and self-guided tours are available.
